Dear Customer,

Thank you very much for diving with Extra Divers Gozo.

Here are some general information around our schedule, arriving and diving on the island:

Check-in and Diving Schedule:

- On the day of arrival, divers should check in at the dive center between 09:00 and 15:00.
- If this is not possible, the latest check-in is at 08:00 on the first diving day.
- Please note: Late check-in arrivals after 08:00 cannot join dives on the same day.

Flying After Diving:

- By Maltese law, divers must have a minimum surface interval of 24 hours before flying.

Airport Transfer:

- We organise an airport transfer through a third-party provider. If you would like to use this service, please provide us with your exact flight number and arrival time.
- The transfer will take you from Malta International Airport to the Gozo Channel Ferry terminal in Cirkewwa.
- Please note that onward transportation from Mgarr (Gozo) to your accommodation is not included.
- Taxis are usually available at the ferry port, or you can book a ride via Bolt or Uber.

General Information related to Diving in Gozo:

- From the age of 60 years, divers must present a valid medical certificate to dive. A self-declaration is not accepted.
- To dive our wrecks in Gozo, a deep diving certification up to 40 meters is required. (PADI AOWD alone is not sufficient)
- All dives are conducted from shore. Divers must be able to walk fully equipped from the car parking to the entry points.
- At some dive sites, divers must climb over rocks and use vertical ladders up to 4 meters high carrying their full equipment.
- Divers with limited mobility cannot access certain sites such as *Blue Hole*, *Billinghurst Cave* or *Cathedral Cave*.
